### 1. Cuvee Jean Paul VdP – Medium

Smooth and supple. Fresh aromas with rounded finish.

### 2. Cuvee Jean Paul VdP – Dry

A fragrant nose followed by crisp green fruit on the palate.

### 3. Cuvee Jean Paul VdP – Red

Medium-full body. Rich fruit flavour and well-rounded.

### 4. Bellefontaine Sauvignon Blanc – Medium

£13.95

This wine captures the fragrant grapefruit flavours associated with the sauvignon grape. A rich wine with underlying crispness.

### 5. Bellefontaine Chardonnay – Dry

£13.95

Selected from quality producers, a fine example of southern French Chardonnay. The full-bodied battery nose is perfectly balanced by tangy citrus flavours.

### 6. Bellefontaine Merlot – Red

£13.95

A rich, aromatic wine with plummy flavours, vibrant youthfulness balanced by a long day finish

### 7. Bellefontaine Rose de Syrah

£13.95

A hint of typical Syrah smokiness is captured on the nose and fresh red fruit flavours on the palate

### 8. Tesoro de los Andes Shiraz/Malbec – Argentina

£13.95

Rich, warm red full of brooding dark damson and bramble fruit flavours that mingle with a twist of spice.

**9. Pinot Grigio – Italy****£15.95**

Dry, full and floral with balanced fruit, Crisp and fresh on the plate, highly versatile.

**10. J.M. Gremillet Brut Selection****£33.45**

This champagne shows fine mousse in the glass and fresh floral aromas mixed with characteristics toasty overtones which are balanced by richer fruit and classic backed biscuit flavours with a crisp citrus finish

**11. J.M. Gremillet Brut Rose****£36.45**

Good fruity champagne with ripe strawberry and vanilla rolling over your tongue. Enhanced by classic baked biscuit flavours and crisp freshness.

A prestigious Champagne

**13. Pol Roger White Foil****£49.95**

Pol Roger was the favourite champagne of Winston Churchill. Elegant and stylish, one of the best of Grand Marques.

**14. Deakin Estate Brut****£19.45**

Fresh and flavoursome with a lively crisp finish.

**22. Primo Prosecco Frizzante****£15.50**

This classic Italian fizz is gently aromatic, crisp and delicate with subtle fresh apple flavours.

## Rose Wines

**15. Casal Mendes Rose****£14.95**

Famous wine of Portugal, medium and easy drinking

**16. Pinot Grigio Rose****£15.95**

Fresh, dry, and creamed with summer fruit flavours. A classic Italian wine with a twist of pink.

## European White Wines

**17. Araldica Piemonte Cortese** **£13.95**

Dry lemony Italian wine with a clean and elegant flavour.

**18. Muscadet de Serve et Maine Sur Lie** **£16.45**

Dry, crisp and clean from the best area of production, Serve et Maine.

**19. Sancerre la Vigne Blanche** **£22.95**

Domaine bottled Loire wine, a lovely "gooseberry" nose, soft and dry.

**20. Chablis la Columbe** **£22.95**

Classic wine from the chardonnay grape, with a fresh bouquet and dry, yet full flavours that last on the palate.

**21. Gewurztraminer** **£18.95**

Alsace wine, great firmness, ripeness and varietal purity with fragrant rose-petal and grapefruit aromas, A spicy complexity.

**23. Pouilly Fuisse** **£25.95**

Crisp fresh elegant Chardonnay from famous Maconnais, truly delicious.

## New World White Wines

**24. Concha y Toro Chardonnay – Chile** **£15.45**

This medium dry wine is unoaked and has a delightful fruity flavour.

**25. Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc – Chile** **£15.95**

Ligt elegant style with citrus and green fruits, accentuated with gentle acidity.

**26. The Landings Colombard Chardonnay – Australia** **£15.95**

Lively citrus fruit flavours, well balanced and refreshing dry.

**27. Trivento Viognier – Argentina** **£16.95**

A wine of complex fruit aromas evocative of peaches apricots and lemons.

**28. False Bay Chardonnay – South Africa** **£17.45**

A supple, fruit-driven wine, lots of juicy tropical fruits with a touch of lime and butterscotch.

**29. Deakin Estate Sauvignon Blanc – Australia** **£17.45**

A distinctive zesty wine, rich flavours of lively citrus and tropical fruit.

## European Red Wines

- 31. Araldica Piemonte Barbera** **£13.95**  
The Barbera is the classic red grape of Italy's Asti area, a ripe, fruity, medium-bodied wine.
- 32. Beaujolais Villages** **£16.95**  
Fully fruity wine from the Gamey grape.
- 33. Fleurie** **£19.95**  
Full, soft fruit flavours and a hint of irises. Silky and scented, Beaujolais at its best.
- 34. Chataeu Neuf du Pape** **£25.95**  
Domaine bottled, a deep red wine with fine fruit and delicious flavour.
- 35. Chianti Classico** **£19.45**  
Full mellow dry Italian wine with good fruit and balance.
- 36. Rioja Tinto Navajas** **£18.45**  
Smooth and full Spanish wine, aged in oak.
- 37. Salice Salentino** **£15.45**  
An exceptional find from southern Italy, soft, fruity, full and rounded.
- 38. Juan Gill Monastrell-Monastrell** **£16.95**  
Deep cherry red in colour with complex aromas of ripe red fruits and hints of oak, a full bodied Spanish wine, richly flavoured with excellent balance and long spicy finish.

## New World Red Wines

- 39. Sierra Grande Merlot – Chile** **£15.95**  
Wonderfully soft plummy estate bottled red wine.
- 40. THE LANDINGS Shiraz Carbernet Sauvignon – Australia** **£15.95**  
Blended from two classic French grape varieties but with its own distinctive Australian style.

**41. Trivento Malbec – Argentina**

**£17.95**

Ripe and lush wine, a lively red colour with smooth tannins and red fruit flavours.

**42. Deakin Estate Shiraz – Australia**

**£17.45**

With aromas of ripe plum, spice and a hint of liquorice, this wine offers rich layers of flavour and integrated oak with a long soft tannin finish.

**43. False Bay Pinotage – South Africa**

**£17.45**

Medium bodied wine with a heady mix of fruit, rich chocolate and plums, supported by soft tannins.
